02 About the courses

The comprehensive basic and advanced courses on vascular surgical anatomy and open surgical techniques are organised for the 27th time by the Vascular International School. We started with the access to leg arteries course, followed by the Vascular Access Masterclass in 2009 (for haemodialysis access). In 2017 we introduced the course on the thoracic and thoracoabdominal aorta and the supra-aortic vessels.

The school's goals are the teaching of topographical and surgical anatomy, surgical basic practices, advanced open surgical techniques and innovations. The courses are based on practical dissection of 5 to 7 cadavers (legs, arms, thoracic aorta and supra-aortic arteries) under the guidance of expert tutors.

The arm and leg courses are particularly recommended for vascular surgeons in training. The thoracic course is designated for advanced vascular and cardiac surgeons.
